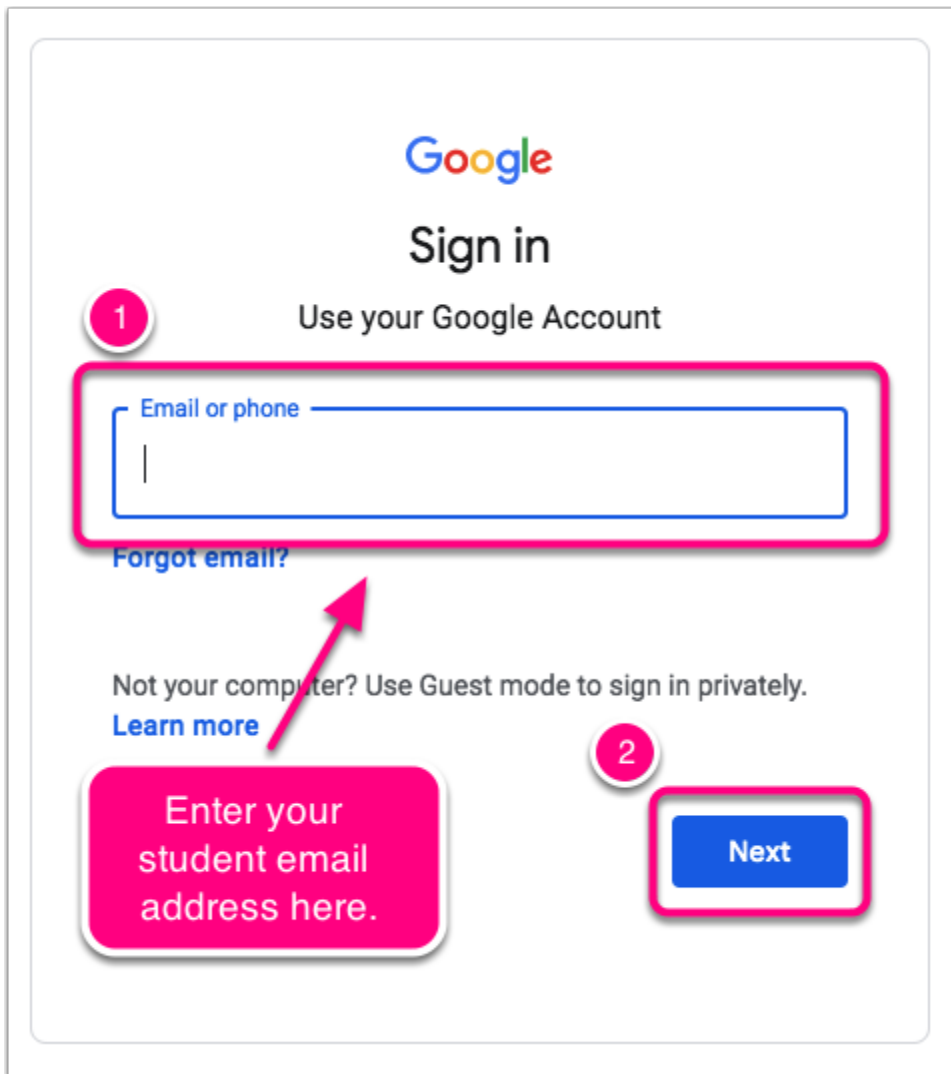


Using Google Classroom

Go to Google Classroom — Step 1

Type classroom.google.com in your web browser (or just click [here](#)). Enter your student email address in the box. Then click **Next**.

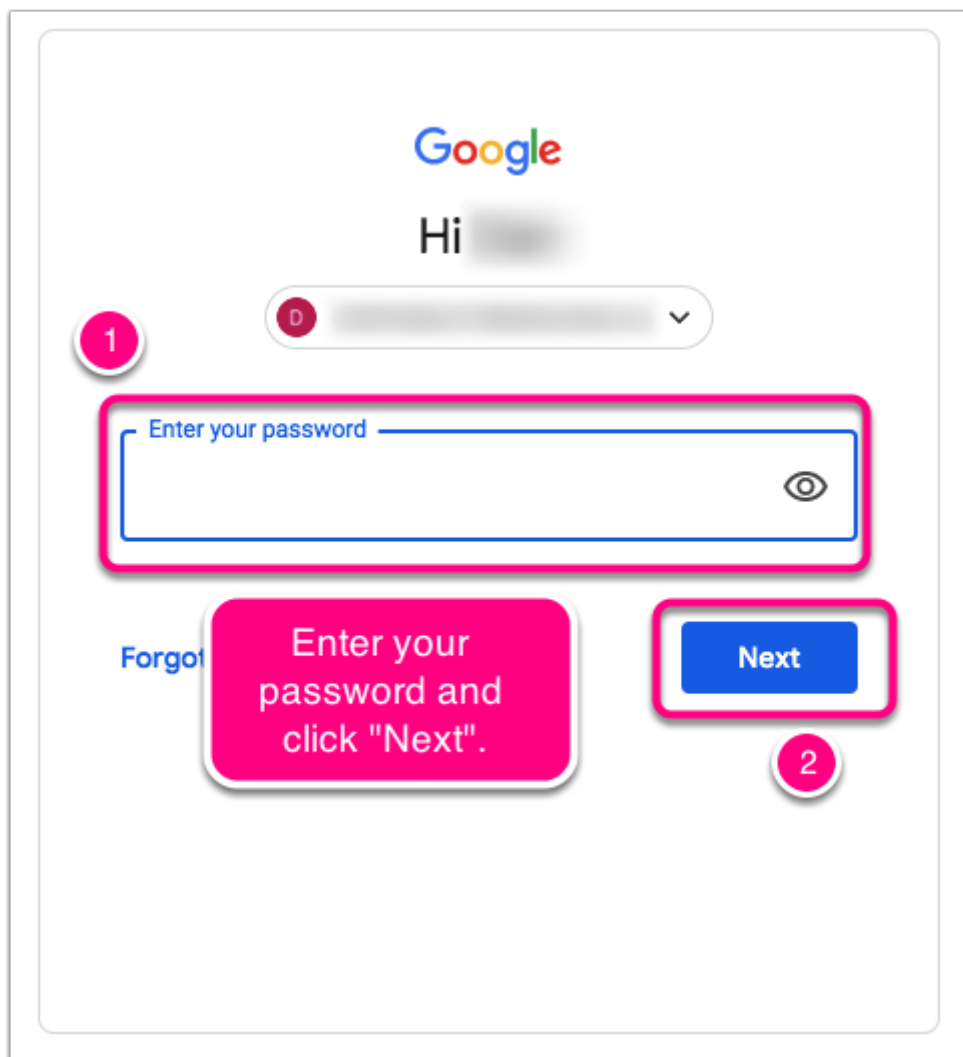

Now **enter your password** and click **Next**.

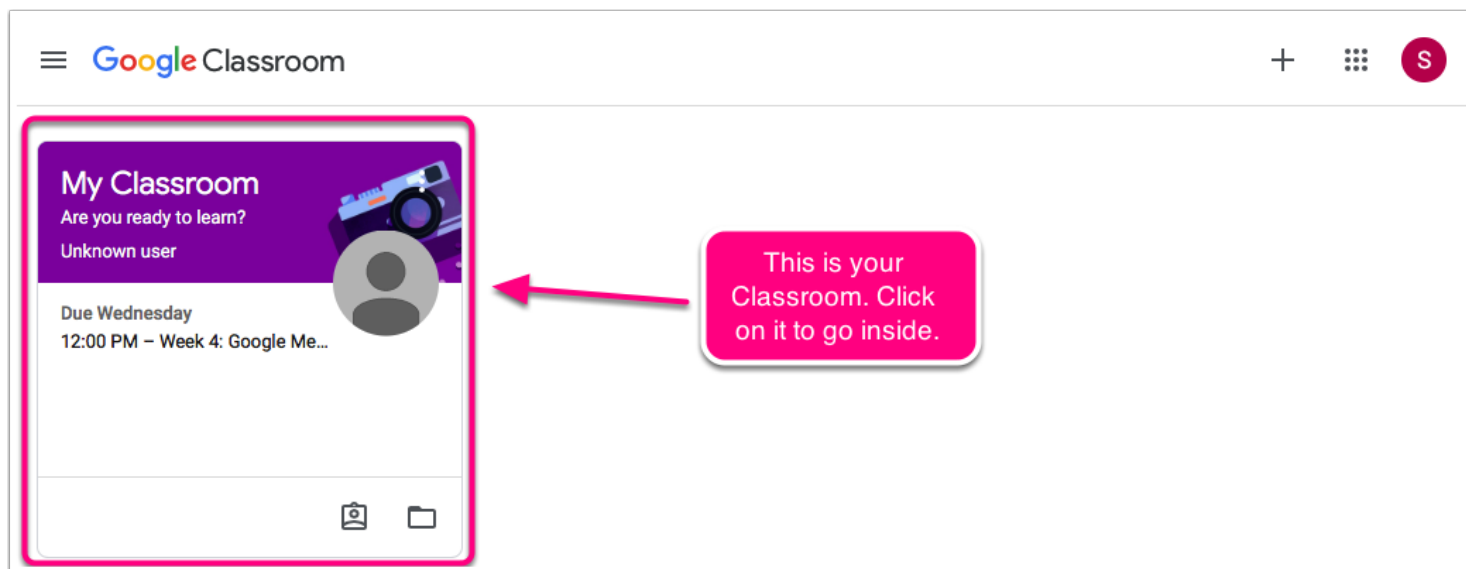

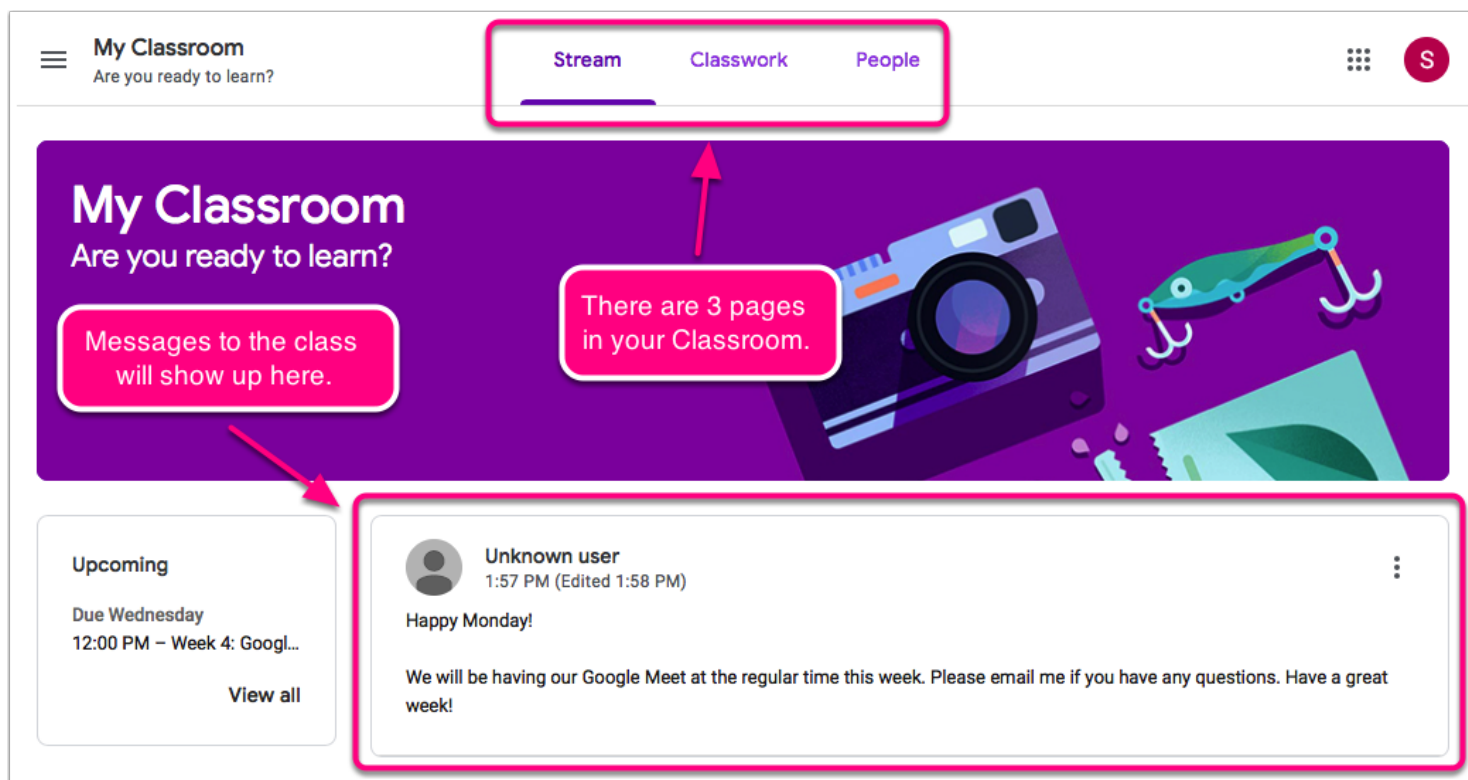
This is what you might see when you first go to Google Classroom.

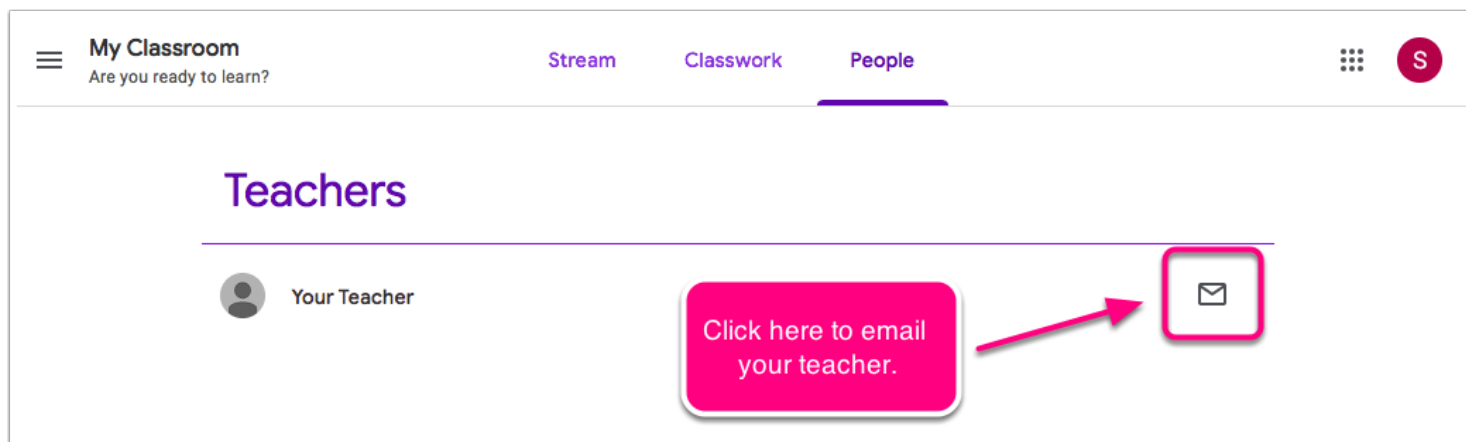

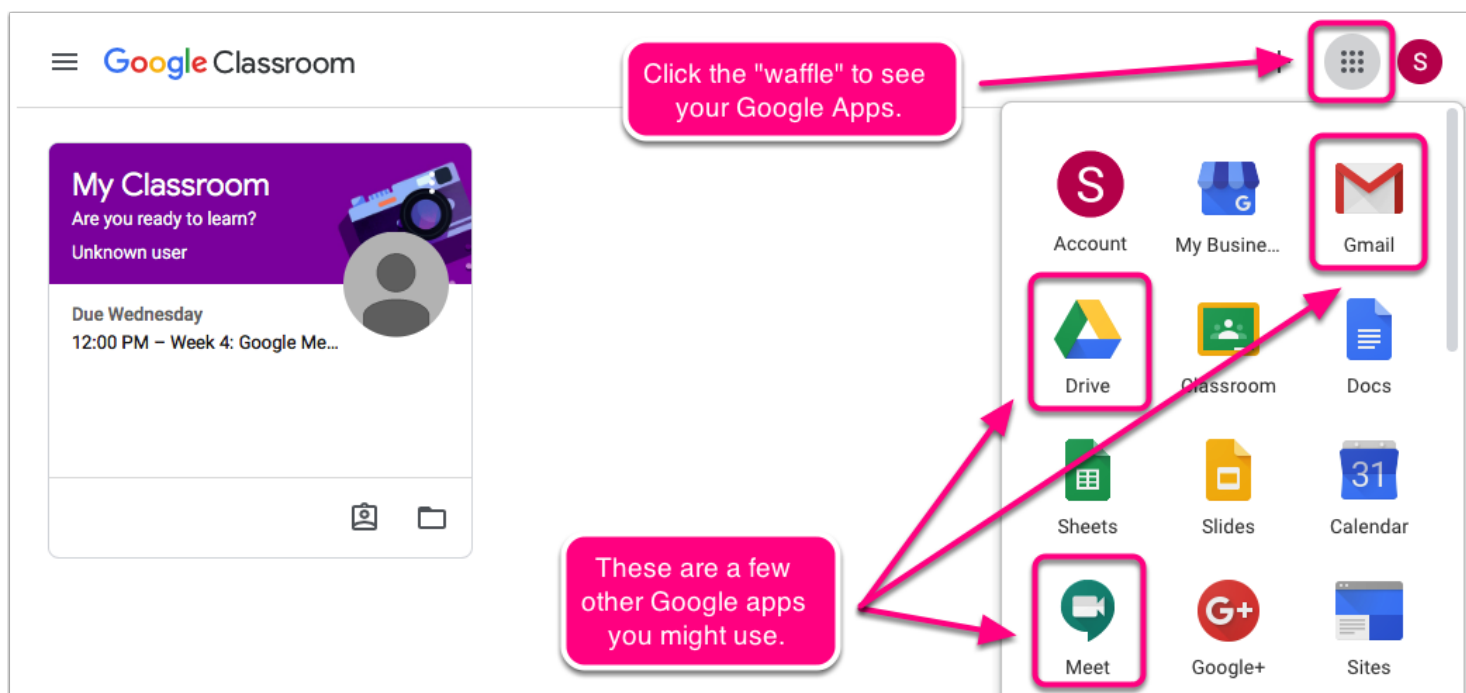
The People Page
