

Getting Ready for Kindergarten **Create a consistent bedtime routine:**







Children age five to six need 9 to 12 hours a sleep a night



Build independence by practicing the following skills with your child:



- Dressing themselves
 - Practice using zippers, buttons and velcro
- Opening/closing snack containers
- Using a water bottle
- Using a bathroom and washing hands
- Turn taking and compromise
 - Play games



Getting Ready for Kindergarten





Read to your child every day:





- Read stories together in your first language
 - Helps develop vocabulary, listening and speaking skills
- Read different types of books
 - Picture books, information books, nursery rhymes, poetry
- Talk about pictures and the story as you read together
- Visit your community library (when possible)

Getting Ready for Kindergarten






Take time to talk with your child about everyday activities:







- Share special activities together, like walks to the park
 Talk about what you are seeing and doing
- Talk, read, sing and play in your first language
- Practice labelling emotions
 - Brainstorm ways to deal with difficult emotions
 - body break, breathing, talking about it with someone
- Emphasize a growth mindset
 - Talk about how it's okay to make mistakes
 - Praise children for their efforts and courage to overcome setbacks



Register for the 2025-2026 School Year

Registration for next school year is now open until June 22.

Register using MyCBE

Families must register by Sunday, June 22, 2025 for students to be added to routes for the start of the next school year.

We continue to accept registrations after the deadline; however, students are added to the closest existing bus stop with available space. Processing times for registrations submitted after the June 22 deadline will be delayed.

Confirmed routes are posted in August. For those who register after the June 22 deadline, it may take until mid-October before your child is able to ride the bus.

Transportation can be cancelled with no financial impact by submitting the cancellation form by Sept. 30, 2025.

- 2. Your home language will help your child to learn. When a child knows about things in the home language, he or she will learn about things in the second language more easily.



First Days of Kindergarten









What to expect...

- No bussing for K students for the first week
- Staggered entry for the first week (2 hours)
 - Students attend either, Tuesday, Sept. 2nd, Wednesday, Sept. 3rd, OR Thursday Sept. 4th
 - Morning Kindergarten: 9- 11am
 - Afternoon Kindergarten: 12:30-2:30pm
- Students should have their backpack, indoor shoes they can put on themselves, a litterless snack and a water bottle on their first day, to learn the routines
- There will be extra teachers to support their first day jitters and students will be well taken care of!
